

HOOKER COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION MEETING
JULY 9, 2026

The Hooker County Board of Equalization convened at 3:45 p.m. in the courthouse on July 9, 2026. Present were commissioners Bryan Crisp, Thad Emerson and Julie Kraye. Also present during the meeting were George Vinton, Jessica Hampton, Mel McDowell, Mick & Midge Harding, Doug Deibler, Doug Cooley, Tim Cheever, Bonnie Hilderhoff, Ted Bradley, Brad & Traci McCully.

Eighteen protests were filed.

Those present to speak in regards to their protest were allotted 5 minutes to speak with the Board of Equalization.

The Board of Equalization took the protests under review and the determination ruling will be presented at the July 23, 2026 Board of Equalization meeting at 4:00 p.m.

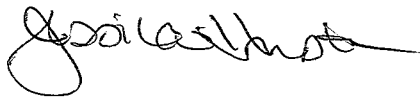
Crisp moved and Kraye seconded the motion to accept the undervalued and overvalued properties as presented. Roll call vote, three ayes, motion carried.

A letter from Traci McCully requesting a tax reimbursement for the error in assessment on the dwelling at 84341 N Hwy 97, Mullen, NE 69152 was presented to the board. After the boards review it was determined to be overvalued property. The property owner did bring the error to the assessor in July 2025 and the error was corrected at that time. The allowed time to protest the error is prior to June 30th of the year the error was determined. Crisp moved and Kraye seconded the motion to dismiss the tax reimbursement request. Roll call vote, three ayes, motion carried.
